Between HEART & MIND

Han Collection is pleased to present this new solo exhibition of Korean artist, Soon Yul Kang, Between HEART & MIND.



This exhibition is an exploration of the space between one's heart and mind and through a quiet contemplation and meditation over one's thoughts and the yin-yang forces in the world.

This is illustrated by Soon Yul Kang's expert usage of traditional style Korean mulberry paper, known as Hanji, which has ritualistic aspects in making and practical side in living. With using powerful and emotive words such as Love, Heart/Mind and Mother, these words are handwritten and then collaged to form the artworks; using contrasting colours, such as blue and red and black and white, she imbues the artworks with a sense of peace, yet thoughtfulness.


Soon Yul Kang draws upon eastern philosophy, such as the yin-yang, and the contemplation of duality and opposing, yet complimentary forces, colours, places, meanings and thoughts. She also explores the use of the Korean symbols for heaven (\circ), earth (-) and man (|).

My works are concerned with meditation, healing and time in conjunction with Eastern philosophy of Yin-Yang: the two complementary forces that make up all aspects and phenomena of life and the Zen understanding of simplicity, stillness, repetition and rebirth. Cultural elements are an important factor and recognisable in my practice. I have been interested in dualities and harmonies within Eastern philosophy through Yin-Yang; through this, I apply colours, circles and squares into my works to give them a universal language. The dualities of black and white, red and blue, heaven and earth, visible and invisible, emptying and filling are based on the concept of Yin-Yang. Yin is a symbol of earth, female, darkness, passivity, square and absorption, Yang is conceived as relating to, heaven, male, light, activity, circle and penetration.

For recent collage works I use traditional Korean mulberry paper, Hanji, which has ritualistic aspects in making and a practical side in living. I grew up with Hanji paper which is connected to my childhood memory that leads to artistic language not just as support material. I chose meaningful words or signs such as LOVE, MIND / HEART and MOTHER for words. LOVE, MIND / HEART are the themes I wish to contemplate upon and are the same to all people. As most of the handwritten words in my works are 사랑 [sarang] (Love) and 마음 [maum] (Mind/Heart) in Korean, these feature prominently within the works. The basic alphabet of the Korean language is also based on the Yin & Yang and five elements of philosophy, and reflects the harmony between sky, earth and mankind: \circ (Heaven/sky), — (Earth), I (Man). I have repeatedly HANDWRITTEN a word on the paper in a Zen like ritualistic practice. I then CUT the handwritten words into very tiny square/rectangle sizes to start with, and carefully STICK each piece together to gradually increase the size as I create a circular form.

Circles and squares refer to the harmony of Yin-Yang, however, I also use circles in my works to convey a sense of immortality and of an on-going journey in life.









